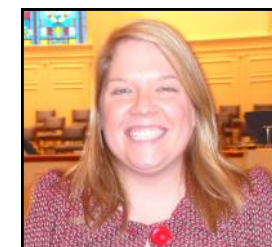
A Night for Missions in Romania

Tonight at 6:00

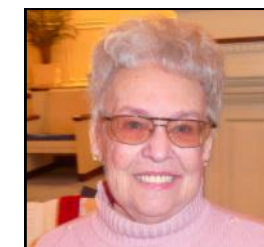

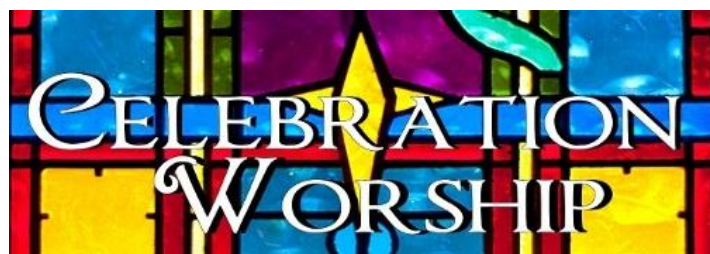
