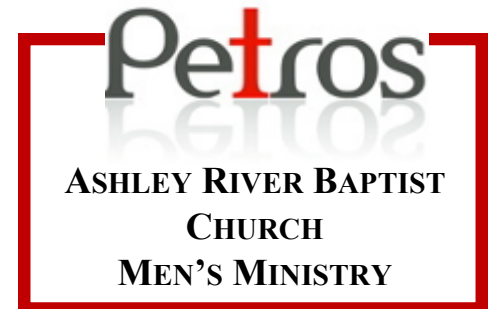
### WEDNESDAYS AT 6:00 PM
